SUNDAY'S GUEST SPEAKER: LUANN GOOSEN



Luan Goosen has been a full-time missionary with Zion Evangelical Ministries of Africa and has been supported by CBC since December 2001.

He was born and raised in the Eastern Cape region of South Africa, where he learned the clicking Xhosa language, which has become such an asset to reaching the rural AmaZioni people in their heart language. He graduated in 1999 from the Baptist Theological College in Johannesburg with a Licentiate in Theology (LTh).

His focus is on soul-winning, discipleship, and theological training. After winning locals to Christ, he works alongside them to establish strong indigenous churches where fully equipped leaders can then reach their own people. He met his wife, Susanne (from York, PA), in the rural area of Mthatha, South Africa, when she was on a mission trip after graduating from Moody Bible Institute.

They have been married since December 1998 and have three children: Pieter (24), Sarah (22), and Katelyn (19).

THE GLOBAL PARTNERS CBC currently supports 24 Global Partner families serving around the world.

Money raised at our auction allows us to provide an extra financial blessing to each family and to fund emergency needs that may arise.

Last year, over \$98,000 was raised! Many of our Global Partners attend the Global Reaching Out Conference and help as “runners” during the auction. It’s a great way to rub shoulders with them in an informal setting. Be sure to get to know our Global Partners while they are here and stay in touch throughout the year by following their updates.

WHAT TO EXPECT at the Missions Auction

An auction is a sale in which items are put up for bid, and people can bid if they want to buy the item. Each person receives a bidder number so auctioneers can keep track of who buys items. If you win the bid, you will need to show your number so they can record it. When you leave, your total will be calculated, and you will pay then.

You never know what an auction item might go for, especially at CBC! Once in a while, you’ll get a bargain, but other times, people will try to outbid each other for a jar of jelly, pickles, or a pecan pie. Many other great items, such as quilts, crafts, paintings, handmade furniture, and tools, are also available. Some things up for bid are for future events like a special meal, a weekend getaway, or a baseball or football game!



ACTIVITIES FOR CHILDREN!
