## ☆ Let's Talk

**SAY** Jesus told his disciples to eat bread and drink wine to remember his death on the cross.


**ASK** *What do you see in the picture?*

**SAY** Jesus was teaching his disciples, and all those who trust in him, that instead of celebrating the Passover meal, we are to celebrate the Lord's Supper. It reminds us that Jesus has paid for our sin, that Jesus rose from the dead, and that one day he will return. When God's people worship him by celebrating the Lord's Supper, it is a joyful time for the church!

## ☆ Let's Do

**1** Draw the outline of a large cross, a plate of bread, and a cup of wine on a large sheet of poster board. Talk about what each picture shows.

- The *cross* reminds us that Jesus paid for our sins.
- The *bread* makes us think about the body of Jesus that was crucified on the cross for our sins.
- The *wine* in the cup makes us think about the blood of Jesus that was shed for our sins.



**2** Let children color the pictures. Then they can make touch-and-feel pictures by **gluing** one or more of the following items on the picture: **cotton, rice, strips of tissue paper, glitter, fabric.**

## ☆ Let's Memorize

Gather in a circle. Teach questions 137 and 140, listed below. Say the question and have the children sit as they repeat it. Then say the answer and have them stand as they repeat it.

First Catechism Q/A 137, 140

- 137 Q.** *What sign is used in the Lord's Supper?*  
**A.** Eating bread and drinking wine to remember the suffering and death of Jesus.
- 140 Q.** *Who may rightly partake of the Lord's Supper?*  
**A.** Those who repent of their sins, trust in Christ, live a godly life, and profess their faith before the Church.
