TIME

Parents, build intentional time into the rhythm of family life for the purpose of thinking about, talking about, and living out the gospel. Use the guide below for family worship.

READ

Mark 5:21–43

- How were the people in this story healed?
- How has God responded to our greatest need?
- How are sinners healed of their greatest sickness – sin?
- How has God responded to our suffering?
- Does God always heal sickness and end suffering right away?
- Will there always be suffering and sickness?

PRAY

Take turns praying together.

- **Praise:** God, You are... (refer to His attributes)
- **Thanksgiving:** God, I thank you for...
- **Lament:** God, I am sad about...
- **Confession:** God, forgive me for... and help me forgive...
- **Request:** God, I ask you for...

SING

Play your favorite worship songs and sing together. Make up motions to your favorite parts!



Moments

Does your family know anyone who is sick? Pray for them and do something kind to encourage them together. You could make them a card, a sweet video message, take them a meal or offer to do a chore for them. Be creative!
