


# MEMORY VERSE CALENDAR 2026

# HEY PARENTS!

Welcome to the Citizens Kids Memory Verse Calendar! In both KidCity and LittleCity (starting in our 3-year-old classes), we focus on memorizing one verse each month to help center your family around God's Word, regardless of the ages of your children! In this calendar we have emphasized three things to help your family learn from and about God's Word in the home:

## 1. MVOTM (Memory Verse of the Month)

This year our theme is "Family of God." Each verse was intentionally picked to teach your children who God has called His children to be. We have highlighted some of the communicable attributes of God, as well as some simple truths about God's children. God's children are called to be holy, good, loving, just, merciful, faithful and wise. God's children are also being transformed and sanctified, and they are encouraging and truthful. We pray that memorizing these verses will produce much fruit in your home and in the lives of your children.

## 2. CHURCH CALENDAR

Practiced for over 1,500 years, the Church calendar serves as a way to order our lives around the Christian story. Inspired by the annual feasts and celebrations of God's people throughout the Old Testament, the calendar can be traced all the way back to the early Church, when Christians began establishing rhythms and rituals based on the one story of Scripture. The gatherings, practices and traditions of the seasons help us remember who God is and what He has done in Jesus Christ and help us to live in that story every day as the people of God.

## 3. LANGUAGE

In LittleCity we teach about who God is and what He has done by highlighting one of five Foundational Truths each week—God Made Everything, God Is in Charge of Everything, God Is Good, Jesus Came to Save Sinners and God Wants to Talk With Us. In KidCity, we focus on teaching the character of God through 21 different attributes. In this calendar, we have provided you with a list of terms and definitions to help you talk about the things of God using the same language that we use on Sunday mornings.



## 40 TIMELINE EVENTS

In LittleCity, we build a foundation of faith for kids from birth through kindergarten by focusing on five Foundational Truths. In KidCity, we expand on these truths with our 40 biblical timeline events.





Throughout the Bible, we see an overarching timeline of God's work, sometimes referred to as the metanarrative. During the course of the year, we refer back to this timeline at various points to help

your child gain an understanding of how each narrative fits into God's Big Story. We hope that by providing a copy for you to use at home, you can continue to help your child grow in their understanding of not only when

things happened but also how we are still waiting with hope for Christ's promised return.

## GLOSSARY

### TERMS FOR TEACHING

**ADOPTION** – Chosen to become part of a new family.

**ANGEL** – A mighty warrior and messenger from God.

**BAPTISM** – To dip someone under some water and bring them back up — like Jesus died and was raised back to life — to show everyone that God has given them a new, healthy heart like Jesus.

**BIBLE** – God's true Word. It is from God and about God.

**A CHURCH** – A group of people who love and trust Jesus.

**THE CHURCH** – Everyone who loves and trusts Jesus.

**COMMUNION** – When God's children eat and drink together to remember His death on the cross, how Jesus' body was broken like bread and His blood was poured out like wine for sin.

**CRUCIFY** – To die on a cross.

**DISCIPLE** – A friend and follower of Jesus.

**GOD** – God the Father is God. Jesus the Son is God. The Holy Spirit is God. There is only one God who is three different persons. God Made Everything. God Is in Charge of Everything. God Is Good!

**GOD'S CHILDREN** – Those who love and trust Jesus.

**GOSPEL** – The good news that Jesus Came to Save Sinners and the whole world from sin.

**HEAVEN** – The place where God lives.

**IDOL** – Anything we love and trust more than God.

**ISRAELITES** – God's special, chosen people.

**MIRACLE** – Something amazing and special that shows God's power.

**PROMISED LAND** – The place God promised to give to the Israelites that was full of good things.

**PROPHET** – Someone who hears from God and tells His people what He has said, like a messenger.

**SACRIFICE** – Giving something special and valuable to God to show Him that He is better.

**SAVES** – Rescues.

**SIN (SICK HEART)** – Anything we do or think that is different from what God wants. Sin starts in our hearts and comes out in our actions. Everyone sins. Sin separates us from God, and we die.

**TEMPLE** – The place where God's people worshiped God together a long time ago.

**TEMPTATION** – When our hearts or other people tell us that sinning is better than obeying God.

**WORSHIP** – How we show that God is most valuable. Only God deserves our worship. We use our voices, minds and bodies to worship God.

## ATTRIBUTES OF GOD

**ALMIGHTY** – Nothing is too hard for God.

**ATTENTIVE** – God hears and responds to the prayers of His children.

**CREATOR** – God made everything.

**COMPASSIONATE** – God sees, cares and acts when His children are in need.

**DELIVERER** – God rescues His children.

**FAITHFUL** – God always does what He says He will do.

**GENEROUS** – God gives what is best.

**GLORIOUS** – God shows His greatness and worth.

**GOOD** – God is what is best.

**HOLY** – God is completely perfect and separate from sin.

**INCOMPREHENSIBLE** – God is bigger than we can understand.

**JUST** – God is right to punish sin.

**LOVING** – God does what is best.

**MERCIFUL** – God does not give His children the punishment they deserve.

**PATIENT** – God is slow to anger.

**PROVIDER** – God meets the needs of His children.

**REFUGE** – God is a place of safety and protection for His children.

**SOVEREIGN** – God has the right, wisdom and power to do all that He pleases.

**UNCHANGING** – God never changes.

**WISE** – God knows what is best.

**WORTHY** – Only God deserves all glory.

## KNOW, LOVE, TRUST AND OBEY

**KNOW** – Not just knowing about God, but being in relationship with Him.

**LOVE** – Seeing God as most valuable.

**TRUST** – Having confidence in God even when our circumstances don't feel good, and even when we wouldn't pick what is happening to us.

**OBEY** – Knowing, loving and trusting God enough to do what He says.

# JANUARY

## FAMILY OF GOD

God is holy! He is completely perfect and separate from sin. God calls His children to be holy too! But how can we be holy if our hearts are sick with sin? Great question! Those who love and trust Jesus are given new hearts with God at the center. God helps His children obey Him each and every day. God's children will never be completely perfect and separate from sin until Jesus returns; however, with God's help, they can live like Jesus did! Obeying Jesus, even when it is hard, always leads to joy. How can you live like Jesus this month?

## EPIPHANY

Epiphany means “to show” or “make known” and is a time when we celebrate that Jesus is the Son of God and the Savior God promised to His people. During Epiphany, we also celebrate that Jesus came to live with His people. During the season of Epiphany, we will learn stories about Jesus being with His people and living a perfect life.



# FEBRUARY



# MARCH

## FAMILY OF GOD

# APRIL

## FAMILY OF GOD

# MAY

## FAMILY OF GOD

God is merciful! He does not give His children the punishment they deserve. God calls His children to show others this same radical forgiveness. God's children can show mercy when they forgive others fully, freely and forever, just like Jesus forgave them. This month, how can you practice forgiving others like Jesus did?

## PENTECOST

During Pentecost, we celebrate that God has given the Holy Spirit as a gift to those who love and trust Jesus. Jesus went back to heaven, but He did not leave His people alone; He sent a Helper, the Holy Spirit. We celebrate how God's children, led by the Helper, began to tell others about how Jesus Came to Save Sinners!

## ORDINARY TIME

During the season of Ordinary Time, we celebrate what Jesus told His disciples to do—go around the whole world telling others about Him. We celebrate what the Holy Spirit, the Helper, is doing in the Church to make disciples. We call this “Ordinary Time” because we tell others about Jesus in the places that we are—in our homes, neighborhoods and schools—until the whole world knows Him!

## FAMILY OF GOD



## FAMILY OF GOD



# NOVEMBER


## FAMILY OF GOD
