






FUSION YOUTH STAFF APPLICATION PROCESS

Fusion Youth Staff Expectations

1. Mandatory attendance at youth staff meetings.

- First Sunday of every month after service or otherwise notified.
- Two Consecutive unexcused misses will result in being asked to step down.

2. Attend Sunday morning service.

- It is important to be poured into weekly.
- Attendance is not required at Fusion Lexington Campus, as long as you attend somewhere.

3. Be involved in all Fusion Students Ministries events.

- Chaperones (realize that Fusion events are for the youth and not staff)
- Set Up and Tear Down
- Arrive First and Leave Last
- PD will advise when you are needed for each specific event.

4. Be Ready to work at the Altar and Small Groups.

- Be attentive to the message so that you know how to pray and lead discussion.
- Know how to lead a student to the Lord, and use salvation packets.
- Respond if a student raises their hand for prayer or accepts the Lord.
- Guys pray with Guys and girls pray with girls
- Report any confessions of abuse, suicide, or other issues the Youth Pastor.

5. Maintain a personal devotional life.

- Spend Time reading the Bible daily
- Spend Time in prayer daily.

6. Team Positions

- Ascribe to the job description, which you agreed upon.
- Be accountable to PD in all areas of Job description and ministry performance.
- If you have a specific area of interest contact PD to begin a ministry in that area.
- Team areas (Media, MC, Small Group Leader, Worship Team, Greeting Team, Cafe Team)

7. Please be on time for all Fusion events.

- Please be at Fusion at 5:45 for prayer.
- Punctuality is very important; time is our only resource we can never get back.

8. Maintain personal integrity

- No secular music in presence of students or profane language.
- Use discretion for what you share on Social Media. We are to be examples to students.
- Do not use alcohol, drugs, or tobacco at Fusion or outside. We are to be an example.
- Do not date (or participate in behavior that appears as dating) a high school student. Even if the student is above 18 years old.
- Sideways Christian hugs are to be used at all times with students of the opposite gender.
- If you are single or dating someone maintain purity in all relationships.
- Wear proper apparel at all times.
- Do not view movies or websites that will damage your testimony. (This includes pornographic material)

- Be loyal to the staff of Fusion Church.
- Please advise Pastor Dan of student situations that need attention.
- Do not Gossip about other staff members or students to other students or staff.
- Respect the property of Fusion Church and Fusion Student Ministries.
- Do not discuss any confidential matters with students.

Remember that you are the example. We die to self so Christ may be glorified and that we may not make a young one stumbling their faith walk. Please make decisions that honor Jesus and others. To whom much is given, much is required. With a higher level of leadership comes a higher level of expectations. These guidelines are very important to our success as a ministry. Thank you so much for your cooperation. Failure to uphold these expectations multiple times will result in you being asked to step down.
