Qualifications & Duties

Note: *As per revision XI, approved 2/26/23, Women who are qualified according to the standards of Article II of the Bylaws shall be eligible for the positions of deacon, trustee and corporate officer. With regard to these positions, all male references in the Bylaws such as "man", "men", "he", and "him" shall be applied in the generic sense so as to include both men and women.*

DEACON:

- Serves SCC and acts in an advisory capacity to the lead pastor in matters pertaining to spiritual life and ministry ordinances.
- Is a man of wisdom, full of the Holy Spirit, involved in the ministry of prayer & service to the members.
- Assists the lead pastor in the administration of discipline at SCC.
- Is a member of the Board Team.
- Serves for a term of three years.
- Performs any other work necessary to properly discharge his duties.

TRUSTEE:

- Is a custodian of all assets and property of SCC. Is responsible for the maintenance of the property.
- Is a man of mature Christian faith, capable of discharging the duties of this office.
- Assists in all service tasks of SCC.
- Is a member of the Board Team. Serves for a term of three years.
- Performs any other work necessary to properly discharge his duties.

SECRETARY:

- Keeps the minutes of all Official Board and Business Meetings.
- Keeps a record of the membership of this Assembly.
- Is a custodian of all legal documents.
- Signs all legal documents when the Corporate Secretary's signature is required, and be an authenticator of the corporate seal, when used.
- Be a member of the Board and serve for a term of three years.
- Performs any other work necessary to properly discharge his duties.

PRESIDENT:

- Shall be a Deacon and serve as President for a term of one year.
- During a vacancy in the pastorate, conduct all Business Meetings and meetings of the Official Board, and act as Chairman of the same.
- Signs all legal documents when the Corporate President's signature is required.
- Performs any other work necessary to properly discharge his duties.
