5. What percentage of your life shows you to be faithfully waiting on the Lord? Why would you say that percentage?
6. What do verses 41-48 teach us about the opposite of faithfully waiting? What are the characteristics of one who is lacking the faith to wait?
7. Where do you struggle to wait on the Lord's return? What causes you to fall short in this area?
8. Verses 49-53 point to the division that will be caused by those who join the kingdom of God and those who reject it. How do you respond to Jesus saying he has come to bring division?
9. What comes to your mind as you read about families split because of the kingdom?
10. What are the ways you have experienced loss and division for the sake of the Gospel?
11. What are areas where you have struggled to focus on the kingdom in light of the things of this world?
12. Take some time as you close to pray for the salvation of those in your life, that you would have true unity in the kingdom. Pray also for boldness as a group to stand strong in a world that rejects the kingdom.
