4. Why do you think Jesus warns the disciples not to tell others he is the Messiah?
5. How would you feel if you were following Jesus in that day (not knowing what would come), and he announced he would die and rise again? What would that make you want to do?
6. How does the suffering and rejection of Jesus match what he has taught already in Luke? (Hint, Luke 6)
7. What does it mean to deny yourself? How are you denying yourself for the kingdom of God?
8. What does it mean to take up your cross daily? How are you taking up your cross daily?
9. What does it mean to follow Jesus based on how you answered the previous two questions?
10. If someone watched your life from the outside, would they think you have taken up your cross and denied yourself to follow Jesus? Why do you answer the way you do?
11. What action steps do you need to take to more completely follow the commands of Jesus in this passage?
