


# The Logic of the Passage




The war we are in is spiritual

C




Therefore, we need armament and weapons designed for this spiritual war if we are to stand victorious.

Our goal is to stand firm in the gospel to the end.









# Why these pieces of armor?

- 6) **Word of God** (Sword)




We are to be arrayed for spiritual  
battle as God is.






