Midianites

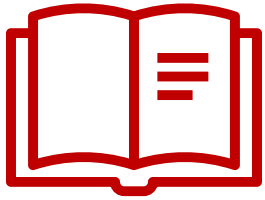

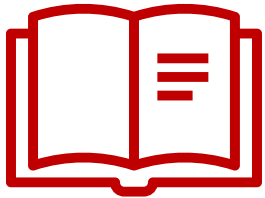

Key Point #4

Salvation and glory and power belong to our God,** ² for **his** judgments are true and just; for **he** has judged the [evil woman (nation)] who corrupted the earth with her immorality, and **[he]** has avenged on her the blood of his servants.”
