



Ephesians 6:4

not to be embittered
towards Him.

The Warning

Fathers, do not provoke your
children to anger

Eph 6:4

Fathers, do not provoke your children, lest they become discouraged.

Col 3:21

What does “provoke” mean?

Do not interact with or respond to your children in such a way that it demeans, devalues, or destroys them.

It does NOT mean
you will never make
your children mad.

A Corrective to a Misapplication

Prov 13:24

Discipline is to be done
with wise restraint
not out of unrestrained anger.

Rules without relationship
breeds rebellion.
