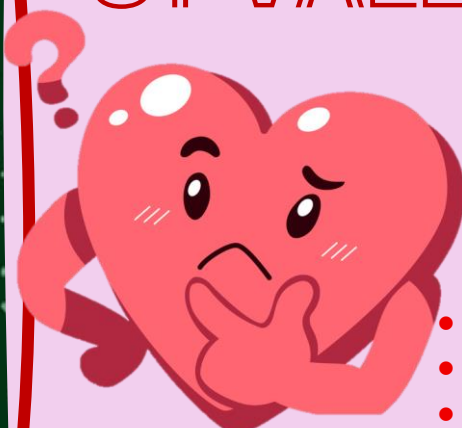

Following our successful pilgrimages to Fatima (2024) and Krakow (2025) Our Parish Pilgrimage for 2026 is to Knock, Ireland. Although this is a 'Parish Pilgrimage' everyone is willing to come along, so if you know anyone who would like to join us, please do invite them!

The programme will be:

Day 1: Depart from Heathrow airport for the flight to Knock on arrival transfer to the Knock House hotel for dinner and 3 nights' stay, Mass will be celebrated before dinner.

Day 2: After breakfast Mass will be celebrated at 10.15am in the Apparition Chapel, after Mass there will be a tour of the grounds and then the opportunity of visiting the Museum. In the afternoon there will be Stations of the Cross, and you will have time to light candles and private prayers. After dinner the Rosary is said at 7.00pm.

Day 3: After breakfast join the coach for a full day excursion firstly visiting Ballintubber Abbey for Mass at 10.00am and a tour of the Abbey after Mass. From here we visit Westport where there will be free time for you to purchase lunch and perhaps do some shopping, we then visit Croagh Patrick Croagh Patrick where St Patrick fasted for 40 days, return to Knock for dinner, Rosary after dinner.

Day 4: After breakfast Mass will be celebrated before departing for the Peyton Centre to watch a DVD on the life of Fr Peyton who devoted his life praying the Rosary, from here we transfer to the airport to join the flight to Heathrow.

Family learning from the Catechism:

This weekend we are encouraged to think more deeply about St John the Baptist's description of the Lord as 'The Lamb of God':

608 After agreeing to baptize him along with the sinners, John the Baptist looked at Jesus and pointed him out as the "Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world". By doing so, he reveals that Jesus is at the same time the suffering Servant who silently allows himself to be led to the slaughter and who bears the sin of the multitudes, and also the Paschal Lamb, the symbol of Israel's redemption at the first Passover. Christ's whole life expresses his mission: "to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many."

613 Christ's death is both the *Paschal sacrifice* that accomplishes the definitive redemption of men, through "the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world", and the *sacrifice of the New Covenant*, which restores man to communion with God by reconciling him to God through the "blood of the covenant, which was poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins".
