The first ever mention of our need for Christ to redeem us comes immediately after the first ever, Original Sin was committed.....

In Genesis 3:15 we read: 'I will make you enemies of each other: you and the woman, your offspring and her offspring. It will crush your head and you will strike its heel'.

The one to 'crush' the enemy is the Lord Jesus.

Many other prophecies followed giving humanity hope, the hope that one day we will be set free from a corrupt and fallen world.

The Prophet Micha tells us where Jesus would be born, for example, Isaiah tells us that He will be **born of a virgin** and, (as we hear in today's First Reading), that He will be descended from Jesse.

The prophets foretold the first Coming (Advent) of Christ (Greek for anointed, Messiah in Hebrew) and we await His Second coming in joyful hope.




Table tennis Saturdays




Family learning from the Catechism:

Advent is a penitential time, time of denying the self, overcoming entitlement and putting God first. Here is what the Catechism has to say about penance:

1434 The interior penance of the Christian can be expressed in many and various ways. Scripture and the Fathers insist above all on three forms, fasting, prayer, and almsgiving, which express conversion in relation to oneself, to God, and to others.

1435 Conversion is accomplished in daily life by gestures of reconciliation, concern for the poor, the exercise and defence of justice and right, by the admission of faults to one's brethren, fraternal correction, revision of life, examination of conscience, spiritual direction, acceptance of suffering, endurance of persecution for the sake of righteousness. Taking up one's cross each day and following Jesus is the surest way of penance.
