We processed into the church carrying candles, (just like the Easter Vigil) being reminded of the Lumen Christi – the Light of Christ, conquering and dispelling darkness.

The Lord tells us in today's Gospel that you and I are called to be light in a dark world by the life we live.

The light we bear shines through our thoughts, words and actions. Let's ask the Lord to truly enlighten us.

Following our successful pilgrimages to Fatima (2024) and Krakow (2025) Our Parish Pilgrimage for 2026 is to Knock, Ireland. Although this is a 'Parish Pilgrimage' everyone is willing to come along, so if you know anyone who would like to join us, please do invite them!

The programme will be: ****UPDATED****

11th May 26: Depart from Heathrow airport at 11.05am for the flight to Knock on arrival transfer to the Knock House hotel for dinner and 3 nights' stay, Mass will be celebrated before dinner.

12th May 26: After breakfast Mass will be celebrated at 10.15am in the Apparition Chapel, after Mass there will be a tour of the grounds and then the opportunity of visiting the Museum. In the afternoon there will be Stations of the Cross, and you will have time to light candles and private prayers. After dinner the Rosary is said at 7.00pm.

13th May 26: We depart the hotel after breakfast and travel to Lough Derg, on arrival there will be a boat tour of the Lake and a DVD will be shown. Mass will be celebrated in St Brigid's Chapel on the Lake shore.

14th May 26: After breakfast Mass will be celebrated before departing for the Peyton Centre to watch a DVD on the life of Fr Peyton who devoted his life praying the Rosary, from here we transfer to the airport to join the flight to Heathrow which departs at 1.05pm.

Family learning from the Catechism:

Christmastide has ended but we have one last reminder of why the Lord entered into time and became man – He is the Light of the World:

529 The *presentation of Jesus in the temple* shows him to be the firstborn Son who belongs to the Lord. With Simeon and Anna, all Israel awaits its *encounter* with the Savior—the name given to this event in the Byzantine tradition. Jesus is recognized as the long-expected Messiah, the "light to the nations" and the "glory of Israel", but also "a sign that is spoken against". The sword of sorrow predicted for Mary announces Christ's perfect and unique oblation on the cross that will impart the salvation God had "prepared in the presence of all peoples".


530 The *flight into Egypt* and the massacre of the innocents make manifest the opposition of darkness to the light: "He came to his own home, and his own people received him not."
