This weekend we commemorate the Solemnity of St John's Lateran Basilica.

St John's is the principal and most senior church in the world.

We often (wrongly) think of St Peter's Basilica in the Vatican as the Pope's Cathedral, but in actual fact, St John's Basilica is the Pope's Cathedral.

In celebrating this Cathedral of Cathedrals we acknowledge our 'Communion'.

Last weekend we thought about our spiritual, supernatural communion with each other as the Church Militant, and our Communion with those in Purgatory – the Church Suffering and also the Company of Heaven – the Church Triumphant.

If we are in a state of grace, we are 'gathered into one by the Holy Spirit' and this physical unity is celebrated today as we honour the 'First church' - the church all other churches are modelled on and find their unity.




