

† CONFESSION OF FAITH

Westminster Confession of Faith, Ch. 8, Sec. 5

Leader: Let us declare together what the Scriptures teach about the Lord Jesus Christ's work as our Mediator:

All: The Lord Jesus, by His perfect obedience, and sacrifice of Himself, which He through the eternal Spirit, once offered up unto God, has fully satisfied the justice of His Father; and purchased not only reconciliation, but an everlasting inheritance in the kingdom of heaven, for all those whom the Father has given unto Him.

GOD CLEANSES US

Within the context of our relationship with God, we are invited in safety, not shame, to consider our sins. God loves us in spite of our sins. We rehearse this truth each week by confessing our sins corporately and leaning into his renewal, restoration, and cleansing.

The scripture that follows our confession assures us of God's forgiveness, grace and pardon. This is the good news.

CONFESSON OF SIN

Leader: Let us now confess our sins together before the Lord we have sinned against even more than we know:

All: Heavenly Father, grant me a deeper sense of my unworthiness that I may delight in your forgiveness. Show me my sin that I may gaze more lovingly at my Savior. Open up the darkest wells of my heart so that I may feel again that Christ's blood covers it all. Deepen my repentance that I may run all the harder toward you. Plough up the soil of my flesh that by your grace seeds of holiness will grow to honor you. For Jesus' sake. Amen.¹
