

**People:** You who have made me see many troubles and calamities will revive me again; from the depths of the earth you will bring me up again. You will increase my greatness and comfort me again.

**Leader:** I will also praise you with the harp for your faithfulness, O my God; I will sing praises to you with the lyre, O Holy One of Israel.

We are a Confessional Church. We choose to stand shoulder to shoulder with those saints who have gone before us. We embrace the timeless doctrinal truths of the Gospel.

## GOD CLEANSES US

Within the context of our relationship with God, we are invited in safety, not shame, to consider our sins. God loves us in spite of our sins. We rehearse this truth each week by confessing our sins corporately and leaning into his renewal, restoration, and cleansing.

The scripture that follows our confession assures us of God's forgiveness, grace and pardon. This is the good news.

Our giving is an act of worship; it is both a response of gratitude for God's generosity toward us and a sign of faith in God's future provision.

## † CONFESSION OF FAITH

The Heidelberg Catechism. Q. No. 28

**Leader:** Let us declare together what we believe: How does the knowledge of God's creation and providence help us?

**All:** We can be patient when things go against us, thankful when things go well, and for the future we can have good confidence in our faithful God and Father that nothing will separate us from his love. All creatures are so completely in his hand that without his will they can neither move nor be moved.

## CONFESSON OF SIN

Based on Lam. 1:20, 3:22-23, Ps. 25:11

**Leader:** Let us confess our sins together before our Lord, so that we may find His mercy and comfort:

**All:** "See, O Lord, that I am in distress; my soul is troubled; my heart is overturned within me, for I have been very rebellious. For your Name's sake, O Lord, pardon my iniquity, for it is great. Through the Lord's mercies in Christ we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not. They are new every morning; great is your faithfulness, O Lord!" In Christ's name. Amen.<sup>1</sup>
