

Within the context of our relationship with God, we are invited in safety, not shame, to consider our sins. God loves us in spite of our sins. We rehearse this truth each week by confessing our sins corporately and leaning into his renewal, restoration, and cleansing.

† **CONFESSION OF FAITH** Westminster Larger Catechism Q. No. 143 & 144

Leader: Let us declare together what we believe: Which is the ninth commandment?

All: The ninth commandment is, Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbor.

Leader: What are the duties required in the ninth commandment?

All: The duties required in the ninth commandment are, the preserving and promoting of truth between man and man, and the good name of our neighbor, as well as our own: appearing and standing for the truth; and from the heart, sincerely, freely, clearly, and fully, speaking the truth, and only the truth, in matters of judgment and justice, and in all other things whatsoever; a charitable esteem of our neighbors; loving, desiring, and rejoicing in their good name; sorrowing for, and covering of their infirmities; freely acknowledging of their gifts and graces, defending their innocence; a ready receiving of good report, and unwillingness to admit of an evil report, concerning them; discouraging tale-bearers, flatterers, and slanderers; love and care of our own good name, and defending it when need requireth; keeping of lawful promises; study and practicing of whatsoever things are true, honest, lovely, and of good report.

CONFESSION OF SIN Titus 1:2; Jn. 17:17; Ex. 20:16; Eph. 4:25; Phil. 4:8

Leader: Let us confess our sins together, acknowledging the sins of our tongues before God and against our neighbor:

All: Lord, you are the God of truth, who never lies. Your word is truth. You commanded us to not bear false witness against our neighbor. We confess that we have sinned against You and this ninth commandment. We have slandered our neighbor's name and reputation, misconstruing his intentions, words, and actions. Forgive us, Lord. We repent of this sin of slander. Teach us to put away falsehood and let each one of us speak the truth with his neighbor, for we are members one of another. May we practice whatever is true. In the name of Jesus we pray. Amen.
