When I was a kid growing up in the South there was always so much excitement leading up to the *possibility* of snow. I remember waking up in the middle of the night to peek out my window, just to see if it was really happening. My brothers and I even did "tricks" to help it snow – Sleeping with our pajamas inside out, putting a spoon under our pillows, and yes... even flushing ice cubes down the toilet. While all of this might sound silly, it reminds me of something beautiful about childhood: the way kids wait with hope, imagination, and expectation.
