Registration is now open for the Fall 2025 MDO program at Enon Baptist Church. We require a completed registration form along with a \$150 non-refundable registration fee, per child, at the time of registration (with the exception of new student online submissions. Please wait to hear from the director before paying your registration fee). All accounts must be current to register.

Orientation for the 2025-2026 school year will be held in August. You will be notified, in late July, once the date and time are confirmed. This notification will come, via text, to the number you provided on your paperwork.

One Time Fees:

\$150 Non-Refundable Registration Fee, due at the time of registration

\$100 Supply Fee, due at orientation (in August 2025)

Book Fees for 3K-\$60 due at time of registration

Book Fees for 4K-\$130 due at time of registration

Monthly Fees:

\$300 – All Ages (three days/week enrollment required)

\$10 discount for each additional sibling

Fees are due on the 1st of each month (August 2025-May 2026) and must be paid by the 10th of each month. If fees are not paid by the 10th of each month, a \$25, per child, late fee will be added. Tuition is due each month. Accounts over 30 days delinquent, will result in a forfeiture of your child's spot in the program. You may choose to pay by check (payable to Enon Baptist Church) or online (through giving at www.enonbc.org/give). We do not accept cash as payment for tuition. If paying online, please create a profile using a parent's name, as this is how your tax document will be created. Do not create/use your child's name. Limit profiles to one per household, if possible.

Fees are based on a set monthly tuition, regardless of the number of days in each month.

Tuition is not adjusted based on absences, unforeseen closures due to weather, and/or holidays.

Salaries and overhead expenses are not reduced based on these occurrences. We hope you understand our need for financial stability, and we greatly appreciate your cooperation in this matter.

We follow Jefferson County School System concerning cancellations and holidays.

Our first day for the upcoming school year will be **Thursday, August 7th, 2025**, and our last of school will be **Thursday, May 14th, 2026**. We will be closed the following days:

Veteran's Day: November 11, 2025

Thanksgiving Break: November 25-27, 2025

Christmas Break: Our last day is Thursday, December 18, 2025. We return on Tuesday, January 6, 2026.

Spring break: March 24-26, 2026

Please refer to the Jefferson County School system calendar for any further days off.
Regarding inclement weather, we follow the decisions of Jefferson County. Please be weather aware.

Clothing: Children should wear comfortable play clothes. Please dress your children in clothing that facilitates diaper changing. **Children should come with plenty of disposable diapers or pull-ups, bibs, burp cloths, and all other needed items.** Make sure your child has an extra change of clothes, including socks, each day. Please make sure that **all** your child's belongings are labeled. **During the potty-training process, we require pull-ups to be used, until your child can remain completely accident free.** This helps us to maintain a clean, sanitary environment.

Lunch: Children need to bring their own nutritious lunch that can be eaten with minimal help. We will be glad to open or help unwrap. Please send your child a **spill-proof cup, labeled with their name.** We ask that they bring water in their cup, and we will refill as needed. We provide a snack. Please refrain from sending items that require heating, as our time is limited during lunch.

BITE POLICY: **We have a rolling 30-day bite policy.** More information will be provided in our information at orientation in August.

Sickness Policy: Children who are not feeling well must be kept at home. Parents will be notified if their child becomes ill and will be required to pick them up at that time.

Please do not bring your child to the program if any of the following symptoms are present or have been present in the last 24 hours:

***ANY fever (even if low grade and/or due to teething or the common cold)**

***Vomiting or diarrhea, no matter the cause**

***Common Cold**

***Symptoms of childhood diseases (including, but not limited to, chicken pox, scarlet fever, strep, HFM, flu, covid, etc.)**

***Sore Throat or Croup**

***ANY unexplained rash or skin infection (ringworms, impetigo, head lice)**

***Lethargic behavior, no matter the cause**

***Discharge from the eyes or nose due to any contagious condition**

***Conjunctivitis (pink eye)**

Your child should be symptom free, without the aid of medication, for a minimum of 24 hours before returning to school. When in doubt, use the “GOLDEN RULE”. Help us, as we do our best not to spread sicknesses throughout our program.

Arrival and Departure: We begin our day at 9:00 a.m. A carline is used for drop-off and pick-up. We unload in the mornings from 8:30-8:50. Please arrive during this timeframe. We load in the afternoons from 12:15-1:00. Please be prompt in picking your children up. Tardiness is not only hard on the teacher, but extremely hard on the children. Please refrain from using your cell phone in carline, so that we may share important daily information about your child. **A \$10 late fee, per child, will be assessed at 1:05, plus \$1 per minute after 1:10. Late fees will need to be paid in cash, at the time of pickup.**

Who may pick up your child: Only parents and authorized adults will be allowed to pick up your child. Let us know ahead of time if there are changes in who will be picking up your child. We will photo ID anyone that we are not familiar with.
