Supplies List 2024-2025

- Pencil pouch with zipper (**NO BOXES PLEASE**)
- 12 #2 pencils – **NO mechanical pencils, please**
- 4 erasers (Pink Pearl or White Pentel suggested)
- 12" ruler with metric measure on one side with clear, visible numbers (**NO rubber rulers, please**)
- CRAYOLA crayons - 3 boxes of 24
- Washable markers – 2 boxes of 10
- Crayola colored pencils – 2 boxes
- 6 glue sticks to start
- 1 bottle of Elmer's liquid glue
- Scissors with rounded edges (Fiskars suggested)
- Student Assignment Book (SAB) to be purchased at EGCA (check price with office)
- **Water bottle for gym and recess (please label and fill daily)**
- 8 red marking pencils with erasers for WRR
- 2 2-pocket folders for homework and class work; vinyl recommended for wear and tear
- Additional supplies may be needed for individual projects throughout the year. Students will be given time to acquire these.
- Bible – students may bring in their own Bibles from home or purchase the CSB translation from christianbook.com

Notebook Standard

In utilizing the Principle Approach at EGCA, we ask that students be equipped with the foundation tool of teaching and learning – the notebook. This is defined as a **hard cover**, 3-ring binder, of a durable quality for the daily use, wear, and tear. These binders are readily available at Walmart, Target, Staples, or any other supplies store in a variety of colors, sizes, and prices. It is recommended that you choose a binder with a spine window for labeling and/or binders of various colors.

Students use these notebooks to maintain a record of their education through the subject organization of regular note taking, assignments, essays, tests, and the proper securing of class handouts. Additional items needed for your child's grade level are listed below.

- 3 **2" binders**
- Index divider pages (tabs) as follows:
 - Book 1: Grammar, Spelling Homework, Spelling Tests, Reading, Handwriting
 - Book 2: Bible, History, Geography, Science
 - Book 3: Math – Lessons, Tests, Fact Sheets, Masters

Parents: Tabs should be in place in the dividers and in the appropriate binder for use on the first day of school.
