Supplies List 2024-2025

- Pencil pouch with zipper (**NO BOXES PLEASE**)
- 12 #2 pencils – **NO mechanical pencils, please**
- 2 erasers (Pink Pearl or White Pentel suggested)
- 12" ruler with metric measure on one side
- CRAYOLA crayons - 2 boxes of 12-24 count
- Crayola colored pencils
- 2 glue sticks
- Scissors with rounded edges (Fiskars suggested)
- Student Assignment Book (SAB) to be purchased at EGCA (check price with office)
- Water bottle for gym and **daily** recess
- 1 marbleized composition book for spelling
- 1 2-pocket folder for homework
- 1 2-pocket folder for classwork
- 2 blue pens; 2 red pens
- 2 highlighters – any color

Notebook Standard

In utilizing the Principle Approach at EGCA, we ask that students be equipped with the foundation tool of teaching and learning – the notebook. This is defined as a **hard cover**, 3-ring binder, of a durable quality for the daily use, wear, and tear. These binders are readily available at Walmart, Target, Staples, or any other supplies store in a variety of colors, sizes, and prices. It is recommended that you choose a binder with a spine window for labeling and/or binders of various colors. **Before school begins, label each notebook with the subject and the full name of the student.**

Students use these notebooks to maintain a record of their education through the subject organization of regular note taking, assignments, essays, tests, and the proper securing of class handouts. Additional items needed for your child's grade level are listed below.

- 5 1" binders: **Language Arts**
 Math
 Science
 History/Geography
 Bible
- Index divider pages – 5 pkgs of 5 count binder tabs
- 2 packages of wide-ruled paper
