

**Kindergarten
Supplies List 2024-2025**

- Pencil pouch with zipper (NO BOXES PLEASE)
- 10 pencils – standard size
- Ruler with metric measure on one side
- **CRAYOLA standard size crayons - 6 boxes of 24** to begin with
- 2 CRAYOLA washable markers – standard size
- Colored pencils – 2 boxes of 12
- Glue sticks – 20 for the year as these are used often in many lessons throughout the year
- 2 bottles of Elmer’s liquid glue
- Watercolors – 16 colors with 1 brush from CRAYOLA
- Scissors with rounded edges
- 2 composition books (wide ruled pages)
- Student Assignment Book (SAB) to be purchased at EGCA office (check price with office)
- **Water bottle for gym and recess (please label and fill daily)**
- \$1.00 to purchase a pencil grip for the first day of school
- **Students will have 1 fruit snack in the morning. Please pack 1 fruit (fresh or canned) and a natural juice (orange, pineapple, apple), milk, or water**
- No individual pencil sharpeners
- Additional supplies may be needed for individual projects throughout the year. Students will be given time to acquire these.



Notebook Standard

In utilizing the Principle Approach at EGCA, we ask that students be equipped with the foundation tool of teaching and learning – the notebook. This is defined as a **hard cover**, 3-ring binder, of a durable quality for the daily use, wear, and tear. These binders are readily available at Walmart, Target, Staples, or any other supplies store in a variety of colors, sizes, and prices. It is recommended that you choose a binder with a spine window for labeling and/or binders of various colors.

Students use these notebooks to maintain a record of their education through the subject organization of regular note taking, assignments, essays, tests, and the proper securing of class handouts. Additional items needed for your child’s grade level are listed below.

PreK and Kindergarten

- 2 2” binders
- 4 – Colored index divider pages
- Small package of sheet protectors

The purpose of the notebook is to introduce children to basic organizational skills and to encourage them to take pride in the progress of their learning adventure.

- ✓ **PLEASE SEND IN A CHANGE OF CLOTHING TO KEEP AT SCHOOL IN CASE OF ACCIDENTS (SWEATPANTS WITH UNDERGARMENTS ARE FINE)**
